## Cutting

## From Fabric A:

- Cut one $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip across the width. Cut four $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- Cut one $12^{5} / 8^{\prime \prime}$ strip across the width. From this, cut a $12^{5} / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square. Cut this square twice on the diagonal to make four side triangles.
- From the remaining strip width, cut one more $8 \frac{1}{2} 2^{1 \prime}$ square and two $6^{5} / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Cut the $6^{5} / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares once on the diagonal to make four corner triangles.


## From Fabric B:

- Cut 11 2½" x 27" lengthwise strips, centering each on the wide stripe as shown here by the black lines. From these, cut $3221 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for sashing.



## From Fabric C:

- Cut two $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips across the width. From these, cut 24 $212^{\prime \prime}$ squares for framed square block cornerstones.
- Cut one $2^{7} / 8^{\prime \prime}$ strip across the width. From these, cut eight $2^{7} / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Cut each once on the diagonal to make 16 triangles for half-cornerstones.


## From Fabric D:

- Cut six $4 ½^{\prime \prime}$ strips across the width. From these, cut $444 ½^{\prime \prime}$ squares for sashing.
- Cut five 2" strips for border.
- Cut five $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips for binding.


## From Fabric E:

- Cut two $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips across the width. From these, cut 16 $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares for sashing.
- Cut four $2^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}}$ strips across the width. From these, cut 64
$2^{1 / 21}$ squares for pieced sashing units.


## From Fabric F:

- Cut seven $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips across the width. From these, cut 104
$2^{1 ⁄ 21}$ squares for pieced sashing units.


## Piecing

Make 32 units as follows:
Place a $2 \frac{1}{2}$ square of Fabric $E$ in one corner of a $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric D square, right sides together. Place a Fabric F square on the opposite corner. Sew from corner to corner on each square, as shown.


Place Fabric E and Fabric F squares on the two remaining corners. Sew as above.

Trim and press to complete
 the units.

Make 4 units in the same manner, using four $2 \underline{1} / 2$ squares of Fabric $F$ for each.


Make four units, adding squares of Fabric F on just three sides. Place the $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ line of a ruler across the unit from corner to corner and trim as shown, to create triangle units for the sides. Discard the lower portion.


Use the 32 Fabric D/E/F units with the $41 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ squares of Fabric E to make 16 rectangular sashing units.

Make five framed square units using $81 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A squares, $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C squares, and $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B rectangles.

Make four side triangle units using the larger triangles of Fabric A.


Make four corner units using the smaller triangles of Fabric A.


Lay out all units as shown in the assembly diagram. Piece the units together in rows, then piece the diagonal rows together.


Piece together the five 2" strips of Fabric D.
Measure the quilt top down the center and cut two strips this length. Sew these to the sides of the quilt.
Measure the top across the width and cut the two remaining strips to this length. Sew these to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Prepare the backing by piecing a 58" square. Layer the backing, batting, and quilt top. Quilt the layers.
Piece binding fabric strips together to make one long strip. Press in half lengthwise, and bind the quilt.
